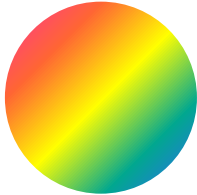


THE PRE-ADAMITE WORLD

ORIGINAL EARTH

In the beginning God created the Heaven and the earth.
Genesis 1:1

D) RESTORATION OF THE EARTH



PRESENT EARTH

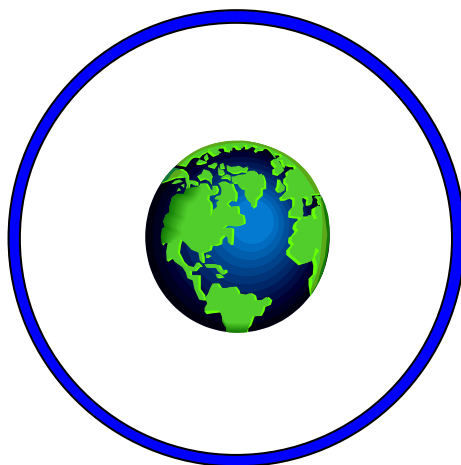
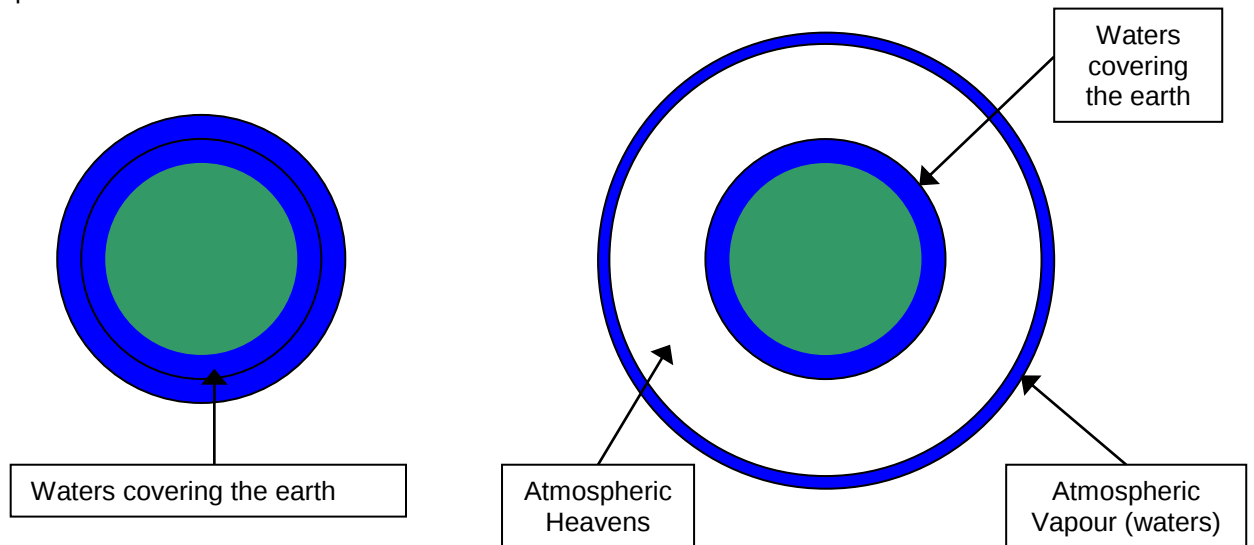
TWO HEBREW WORDS:

asah - To restore, reveal unveil, bring forth

bara – To create

First Day: "And God said, Let there be light: and there was light. And God saw the light, that it was good: and God divided the light from the darkness. And God called the light Day, and the darkness he called Night." Light restored! If the sun, moon and stars were only "created" on the fourth day, where did the light come from on the first day?

Second Day: God divides the firmament – vapour above from the water below, both within the atmospheric heavens around the earth. Everything was already there but just had to be separated.



Third Day: God separates the water around the earth. The dry land is called earth and the waters called seas. “And God said, Let the earth bring forth grass, the herb yielding seed, and the fruit tree yielding fruit after his kind...”

Fourth Day: Sun, moon and stars become totally visible (asah).

Fifth Day: Sea life and birds are created (bara).

Sixth Day: Animal and insect life is created. Then man is created...And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and

over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth. So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them. (bara)

Mankind instructed to replenish the earth, or repopulate the earth. Does this not indicate that it WAS populated at some time prior this instruction?

Seventh Day: Thus the heavens and the earth were finished, and all the host of them. And on the seventh day God ended his work which he had made; and he rested on the seventh day from all his work which he had made.
